## Objectives of the event

The multiplier event organised on the International Women's Day 2022 (8<sup>th</sup> of March every year) had a purpose to showcase and elaborate on all the outcomes, processes, and materials produced for this project. The event was co-hosted by the Municipality of Latsia, and we invited youth workers, organisations, politicians, stakeholders and other participants to join this event to introduce them to the project and well as the main concepts of restorative justice, media education and gender-based violence. The event within the context of the International Women's Day allowed us to engage with the participants and parallel their own work with the outcomes of the C4C project. This was also the first event post-covid that we could interact with each other without the covid-related restrictions such as wearing masks in closed areas (as everyone were vaccinated (and signed declaration of covid-risk management)). This event allowed us to present to the municipality outreach, staff and related stakeholders the outcomes of this project about gender-based violence and its surrounding topics.

## Agenda

The event had 2 major parts. The first part was in a large area that everyone was included and the day began at 9:00 and started with a 30-minute registration window with morning refreshments and breakfast elements. At the induction phase of the event a mayor representative delivered the speech about the International Day and revealed the strategy of the municipality in ending the wage gap between genders as well as the current statistics about violence, employment and other general overview of the current stands on various topics regarding women. Then the president of our organisation Marios Efthymiou was congratulated by the mayor representative for organising this event and then spoke about the overall project objectives of the C4C project. The first part of the event ended with the politicians and other municipality staff exiting the event main hall. Then a small break followed and the second part of the event took place in a smaller hall in which the remained invited participants, organisations and other stakeholders that wished to remain for the main part of the presentation were welcomed by Theo Mavrosavva our International Projects Manager, who presented the project breakdown and guided the participants on the overall outcomes of the project. The second part was mainly focused on presenting all Intellectual Outputs in details and their findings along with all materials produced. Namely IO1: Competence Framework and the Self-Assessment tool, where the participants had the opportunity to interact with the tool via a provided QR code. Then the IO2 presenting the e-courses and inviting the participants to enrol and lastly then followed with IO3 and presenting the findings of both e-books published by our project. The event concluded at 13:30.

## Organisation

### *How the event was disseminated*

The event was primarily disseminated through all our social media platforms, personal emails and phone calls to the municipality and specific targeted organisation that work with these or similar concepts. We involved the Cyprus Youth Council and Nautilus SAR in order to reach the local target outreach. We printed a few invitations and posted them on the municipality billboards and sent via email to various organisations and people.

### *How pre-registration took place*

The pre-registration took place by email confirmation (requesting in Latin characters their name, surname, email and possible organisation/role[optional]). The pre-registration consisted of various covid-related declarations and confirmations of attendance.

### *Location and facilities booked*

The event took place in 2 different halls of the Municipality (Town Hall) building and library in Latsia, suburb municipality of Lefkosia. Upon arrival participants would register their name and organization along with their city and country and then sign next to it.



## Participants

The total number of participants although not everyone registered for part 1 of the event, the registrations for part 2 were as follows:

- 18 from Cyprus (11 from Nicosia, 2 from Avgorou, 5 from Larnaca)
- 2 from Latvia (both from Riga)
- 2 from Bulgaria (1 from Varna, 1 from Sofia)
- 3 from Poland (1 from Poznan, 1 from Warsaw, 1 from Krakow)
